Please indicate on the permission slip if you are available to drive.

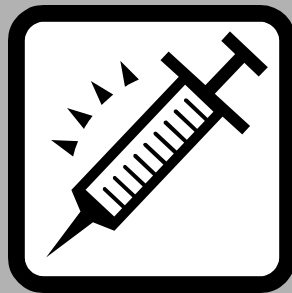
Immunizations
